NEW CHANGES TO AZ H.S. BASKETBALL

AIA CHANGES

Arizona high school basketball has recently gone through some major changes. The Arizona Interscholastic Association voted for a new division structure starting in the 2011-2012 season for all high school athletics.

The 1A-5A classifications have been replaced by five athletic divisions, which vary depending on how many schools compete within each sport. Each division will be made up of three sections comprising schools from the same geographic areas. Sections have replaced the previous region system – Southern, Kino, Sonoran, Gila, etc.

The AIA's main intentions are to increase competition across the board, decrease the total amount of state championships earned each year, and reduce the amount of travel for schools during the season and post season. In the 2009-2010 season 7 championships were earned, but under the new system the 2011-2012 season will only see 4. Overall across the board the AIA will have cut championships down from 114 to just 67 in hopes to increase the overall competitive level of Arizona athletics.

SCHEDULING

Computers, which base each selected game by location, will do the scheduling for each season. This is most likely why we play Sahuarita on back-to-back nights to end the season! In addition to playing teams within your division-section, the computer also selects schools in your geographic region that may be one division above or below you. This season we play D1 Marana and Ironwood Ridge and D3 Rio Rico.

SECTIONAL-TOURNAMENTS

Another change is that the 2011-2012 season will see a sectional tournament in February just before state playoffs start. The top eight teams from each section within their specific division will compete in a single elimination tournament (3 wins = Section Champion).

Think of the Pac-12 tournament before the NCAA tournament starts.

STATE-CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Basketball state championship will be decided in a 24-team, singleelimination tournament in each division. Twelve of the 24 teams in each bracket would be automatic qualifiers, with the top eight earning first round byes. The rest would earn at-large bids based on power points and possibly sectional tournament results.

The hope is to create a NCAA March Madness feel.

POWER-RANKINGS

All regular season games (excluding invitational tournament games) versus AIA member schools count for power rankings.

The Formula:

.50 (Victory Points) + .45 (Opponent Victory Points) + .05 (Opponent's Opponent Victory Points)




